Matahari philosophy

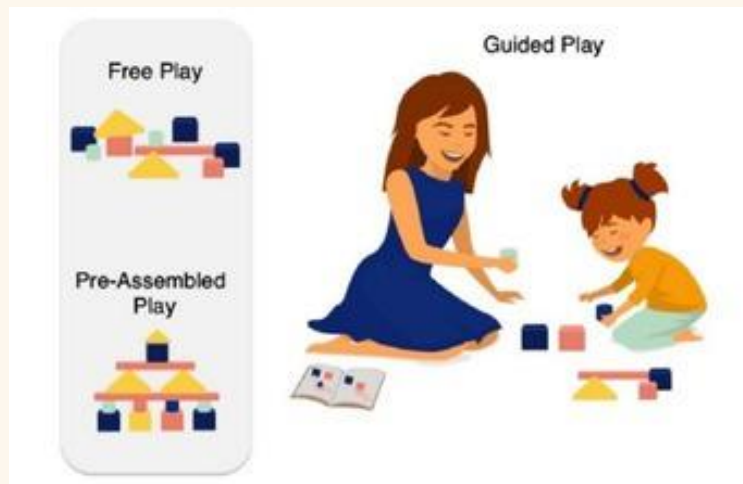
Matahari Cunggu values two key elements in learning: a child's autonomy and adult guidance.

The Integration of Free and Guided Play

Children thrive when they engage in free play paired with active engagement. This combination makes learning advantageous for the child's focus and encourages interest about learning through connection.

Examples of Free Play:

- Children direct their choices in a given environment
- Children experiment with new materials
- Children test ideas through play
- Children design creative roles and activities



The teacher's role in guided-play is active, although not dictatorial. Matahari Cunggu teachers in a guided-play situation might initiate the play context but do not direct it within that context. Rather, the teachers follow the child's lead and allow the child to engage in discovery within the context of a prepared environment and with subtle scaffolding. Although this approach allows children the maximum amount of freedom, it also means that with the teacher's gentle guidance they will achieve learning goals.





Guided-play

It always sees the child as an active collaborator in the process of learning.

Adults play an important role in expanding the child's learning during guided-play, teachers may gently intervene in activities that young children find engaging and motivating.

Guided-play is a shared experience between adults and children where our teachers provide scaffolding to boost language, development and learning. When using guided-play to enhance a child's educational growth, teachers will:

- Prepare the environment
- Set up engaging materials
- Observe
- Follow the child
- Imitate and expand
- Model new skills
- Engage in purposeful conversation



Guided-play, being the main focus by our teachers, will help our kids to make a choice of what activities they like the most and in what areas they would like to express themselves and have an amazing opportunity to develop socially, physically, emotionally and linguistically.

During play, children develop caring friendships with peers and trusting relationships with adults. These shared collaborations will become a secure and treasured foundation for the healthy and satisfying choices children will make throughout their lives.





MATAHARI CURRICULUM

We believe that play is fun, flexible, voluntary and intrinsically motivated. It involves attentive engagement and often incorporates make-believe. Matahari curriculum is based on providing education that offers children an opportunity to experience learning within a safe and protected space, with uninterrupted time and freedom to imagine, create, practice blossoming skills, as well as, discover new interests.

To enable this level of learning and development Matahari Canggü presents tools and areas to stimulate growth, such as:

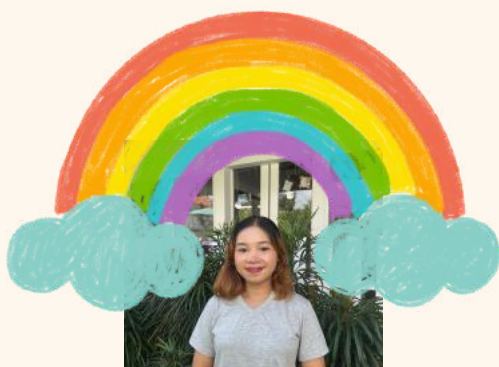

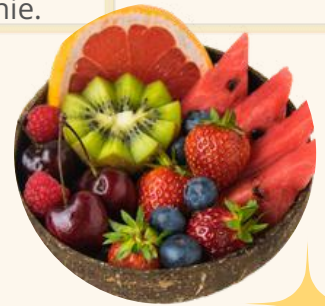

- It's also a great opportunity for children to experience the **joy of music** and movement in a supportive and engaging environment.
